Competency Based Assessment Test

Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six months Training) Rules, 2014.

As per directions by the Government of Haryana, the Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak shall be conducting the Competency Based Assessment Test on 28.12.2023 between 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM as per the Calendar of Events which has been notified both on the University website as well as on the official website of the Office of the Director General Health Services, Haryana, in accordance with the syllabus/guidelines/scheme of examination mentioned in the Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six Months Training) Rules, 2014, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health and Family Welfare), Government of India Gazette Notification, dated 9th January 2014. The eligible candidates are therefore advised to download the application form made available on the University website and submit the same duly filled in to the office of the Controller of Examinations, Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak, after getting the same verified and forwarded by the Civil Surgeon of concerned district latest by 20.12.2023 upto 05:00 P.M. The application form must be accompanied either by a Demand Draft amounting Rs.5000/- (prescribed fee) in original or proof of Rs.5000/- deposited by the candidate through Debit Card / Credit Card towards the examination fee in the favour of 'Controller of Finance, Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak'. The candidates are, thus, advised to refer to the 'Calendar of Events' that has been uploaded on the University website for further details and also to periodically visit the University website as well as the official website of the Office of Director General of Health Services, Haryana for further updates.

It is further clarified that in compliance of the orders of Hon'ble Apex Court in SLP (C) No. 3058 of 2020, titled as "Anil Wasti and others versus State of Chhattisgarh and others" the following directions have been issued:

"By way of interim relief, it is directed that no penal action will be taken against a doctor who has put in practice for not less than 15 years, in case he does not take the proposed examination. It if, however, made clear that candidates are free to take the proposed examination".

* Notification regarding commencement of practical examination shall be notified on the University website in due course of time.

Instructions to the candidates:

1. There shall be one theory paper of duration of 02 hours and a maximum of 100 marks, divided into two sections; A & B.
- *2. '**Section A**' shall consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 1 mark each.
3. There shall be no negative marking for the MCQs.
4. There shall be jumbling of the MCQs in Section A of the Question paper, and accordingly, Question paper booklets of four codes, i.e. A, B, C & D shall be prepared.
5. Each candidate shall be provided question paper booklet of one of the code and a double copy OMR based answer sheet.
6. The candidate shall be required to attempt the correct / most appropriate option (answer) for the MCQs on the OMR based answer sheet provided.
7. The candidate can retain the second (impression) copy of the OMR sheet with himself/ herself.
8. The '**Section B**' of the Question paper shall consist of 10 questions of 5 marks each, to be attempted as short notes on the 2nd part of the booklet, the candidates are requested to attempt short notes on the space provided against each question.
9. The syllabus of the Examination shall be as per the guidelines / syllabus mentioned in the Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six Months Training) Rules, 2014, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health and Family Welfare), Government of India Gazette Notification, dated 9th January 2014.

IMPORTANT

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Candidate must bring along with him/her a legibly printed Admit Card along with a recent colored passport size photograph pasted on it that is duly attested by a Gazetted Officer and one photo identity proof issued by the Government like Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Voter ID Card, Passport etc. at the Examination Centre, failing which the candidate will not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre.
2. Candidates are directed to report at the Examination Centre on 28.12.2023 (Thursday) at 10:00 AM sharp.
3. The candidate shall be subjected to manual frisking at the time of entry into the examination centre by the security guards stationed at the examination centre carrying hand held metal detectors.
4. **Candidate is warned not to carry any electronic device like Mobile Phone, any type of watch/belt/any other electronic/communication device/ Bluetooth device etc.**
5. **Wearing of any types of ornaments like ring, chains, earrings etc. is strictly prohibited. Carrying of any type of stationery material like eraser/sharpener/blade/white ink/eraser fluid/hand bag/purse/wallet is not allowed.**
6. Candidate is required to bring along with him/her one black/blue ball point pen to shade the bubbles/correct answer on the OMR sheet.
7. Candidate possessing any such material at serial no. 4 & 5 shall not be allowed to enter in the examination hall. Any such material found in the possession of the candidate shall be confiscated & a case of indulging in unfair means shall also be registered.
8. All candidates will be subjected to Biometric assessment, still photography and videography.
9. If, the candidate is found to have committed an act of impersonation, then the selection of such candidate shall be cancelled and legal action against the candidate and the impersonator shall be taken as per the provision of law and the University regulations.

10. The candidate must ensure that the admit card is duly signed by the invigilator on duty.
11. Section 'A' of the question booklet contains 50 questions of one mark each. Section B of question booklet contains 10 short notes have 5 marks each. There is no negative marking.
12. **Candidate shall ensure at the start of the examination and within first five minutes, that all the pages of his/her test booklet are properly printed and numbered in proper sequence and that the test booklet is not damaged in any manner. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should immediately report the matter to the invigilator for replacement of test booklet. No claim in this regard will be entertained after five minutes of the start of examination.**
13. Candidates need to fill the test booklet code on the OMR Answer Sheet in a correct & proper manner. If the space for the Booklet Code is left blank or more than one booklet code has been filled up or the name and roll no. has not been filled up as per the instructions provided, it will be deemed to be an incorrect booklet code & Answer Sheet will not be evaluated. The candidate himself/herself will be solely responsible for all the consequences arising out of any error or omission in writing the test booklet code.
14. **Candidate will not be allowed to leave the OMR sheet blank. If any OMR sheet is found to have been left blank, it shall be crossed by the invigilator with his/her signature and mentioning "CANCELLED" on it.**
15. Candidates are warned not to fold, tear, destroy or make any stray marks on the OMR Answer Sheets. Use of Eraser, Nail, Blade, White Fluid/whitener etc. to smudge scratch or damage the OMR sheet in any manner during Examination is strictly prohibited. Candidature/OMR Sheet of candidate found to be using Eraser, Blade, Nail, or White Fluids/Whitener to smudge, scratch or damage the OMR sheet in any manner shall be cancelled.
16. **Each question has four alternative choices, out of which there is only one correct option. For each question, only one circle on the OMR answer sheet deemed to be correct answer is to be darkened/shaded with only Blue/Black Ball Point Pen.**
17. **Pencil should not be used for darkening the circle. If, more than one circle is found darkened, that answer will not be evaluated. Further, if a candidate darkens more than one circle and smudges/scratches any place in any manner with Eraser, Nail, Blade, White fluid/Whitener etc., then in such circumstances the OMR /Answer Sheet and candidature of the candidate shall be cancelled. The candidate himself/herself will be solely responsible for this.**
18. The candidate must comply with the instructions mentioned above in the Question booklet, OMR/Answer Sheet etc. The candidates are therefore, again advised to read and understand the instructions carefully given by the University through Admit Card/Question Booklet/OMR/Answer Sheet.
19. **If a candidate does not comply with the instructions as mentioned above or creates any kind of indiscipline, the University shall take strict appropriate action as per rules and in addition can also debar the candidate from appearing in the future Examinations, to be conducted by the University and also initiate criminal proceedings against the candidate.**
